

Important Customer Information – Vinyl/Coated Upholstery Care

General Maintenance

It is recommended that coated fabrics be cleaned weekly/fortnightly using a sponge/cloth with warm soapy water. Dry with a clean cloth as this will remove dust and general soiling that can stain the product over time.

Spot Cleaning

For spot cleaning, we recommend a 50:50 solution of Methylated Spirits and water. Rub the affected area gently, and follow with warm soapy water to remove residue. Most stains will lift off easily.

Sanitising/Disinfecting Using Bleach Solutions

A 10% household bleach (Sodium Hypochloride) with 90% water solution (500ml bleach with 5L water) can be used to disinfect/sanitise the following products:

- Harper Vinyl
- Linea Vinyl
- Marlo Vinyl
- Quantum Vinyl
- Studio Encore Vinyl
- Tessuto Vinyl

IMPORTANT - After cleaning, it is essential to wipe the vinyl down with a damp cloth soaked in fresh water to neutralise and REMOVE chemical/bleach residue, then allow to dry thoroughly. Failure to remove the accumulated residual cleaning chemicals will cause hardening and cracking of the vinyl surface over time.

Dye Transfer

Dye transfer from blue jeans and other items of clothing can stain the surface of light coloured vinyls. It is important to treat the stain promptly using the Spot Cleaning Method. If the dye penetrates the surface of the vinyl, it will be harder to completely remove.

General Information

- Do not scrub with abrasive cloths, powders, household cleaners, or solvents.
- Do not dry clean or machine wash.
- The hardening of a PVC surface is not considered a manufacturing defect, but is rather due to improper cleaning or the build up of soiling, perspiration and body oils.
