- Improve waste streams reduction/separation of waste yarn, fabric and other waste types.
- Reduction of effluent and compliance with legal requirements.

Energy Policy:

We are committed to developing and maintaining a high standard of energy awareness:

- Energy Management is fully supported by the entire management team.
- Reduce energy use by 20% within a 3 year period.
- Reduce our carbon footprint & continue our offset programme.

Sustainable Sourcing and Product Policy:
